

## Schedule 7 – Academic Delegations

- (1) Academic delegations are prescribed by the RMIT statutes, regulations, resolutions of the Academic Board, and policies approved by the Academic Board. The Academic Delegations Schedule provides a register of academic including research delegations.
- a. The Chair, Academic Board must be consulted on any changes to this Schedule.

Position or body with Delegated Authority	Description
Academic Board	Approve all higher education and vocational education and training including Higher Degrees by Research awards conferred by the University, including VE training packages or changes to delivery location or partners.
Academic Board	Approve academic and research policies
Academic Board	May by resolution delegate any of its powers, authorities, duties and functions (expressly reserving this power of delegation and the powers referred to in the Statute) to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. a committee or board nominated by it,</li><li>ii. a member of the Academic Board, or</li><li>iii. a prescribed officer of the University,</li></ul> Provided that no such delegation will prevent or otherwise limit the Academic Board in the exercise of its powers, authorities, duties or functions.
DVC	Approve initial submissions for external professional accreditation
Heads of Schools	Approve renewal submissions for external professional accreditation
