

Academic Colleges Regulations

Part A - PRELIMINARY

1. Purpose

(1) The purpose of these Regulations is to make provision for the establishment of Colleges.

2. Authorising Provision

(2) These Regulations are made under the <u>RMIT Statute No. 1</u> and sections 28, 29 and 30 of the <u>Royal Melbourne</u> <u>Institute of Technology Act 2010</u>.

Part B - ACADEMIC COLLEGES

3. Colleges

- (3) Subject to University legislation, each college:
 - a. carries out such teaching, research, training, examinations and other higher education and vocational educational and training activities as the Academic Board approves, and
 - b. regulates its own administrative and academic affairs in accordance with the relevant policies and procedures.
- (4) Each college has the following members:
 - a. all staff of the college howsoever employed
 - b. all students enrolled in the college, and
 - c. such other persons as may be prescribed by the Regulations.

Part C - REVOCATION OF REGULATIONS

4. Revocation of Regulations

- (5) On the commencement of these Regulations the following Regulations are revoked:
 - a. Regulation 2.9.1 The Portfolio Boards.
